Prohibited and Conditionally Accepted Materials

- 1. No compressed gas cylinders or closed drums (without valves removed or one drum-end opened)
- 2. No explosive/combustible solids or liquids
- 3. No electronic waste including TVs, Computers, microwave ovens or items containing CRTs, LCDs.
- 4. No radioactive, HazMat or asbestos materials
- 5. No tar or grease containers
- 6. No tires
- 7. No railroad materials (except from railroad owner or authorized agent)
- 8. No automobiles (except under commercial contracts)
- 9. No city or municipal property (except from government agency or licensed contractor
- 10. No drums/barrels unless end removed, and EPA certified clean or food type verifiable by sight
- 11. No firearms. Munition scrap and spent casings accepted if segregated and delivered to designated nonferrous area.
- 12. No oil cans, or un-punctured and drained oil filters/oil pans
- 13. No CFCs, HCFCs and/or substitute refrigerants
- 14. No Gasoline, Diesel Fuel, Oils, Propane, Petroleum Products
- 15. No USTs, ASTs, gas or diesel tanks (except where 4-ft hole in each end and EPA certified clean)
- 16. No items containing PCBs (e.g., capacitors, ballasts, transformers) Materials bearing "NO PCB" mark are accepted.
- 17. No solid or liquid waste separated or contained with loads or organic compounds capable of volatilization (i.e., petroleum based coated items); no organic waste or food products
- 18. No AC units, freezers, refrigerators, or appliances with Freon (except under commercial contracts or scale ticket certification of proper refrigerant removal)
- 19. No cracked, broken or burned batteries
- 20. No fluorescent or mercury vapor lamps
- 21. No free-flowing liquids of any kind, including water
- 22. No pyrotechnic devices including airbags containing sodium azide
- 23. No aerosol containers or cans unless depressurized
- 24. No items containing paint, water sealer, pesticides, or other toxic chemicals
- 25. No excessive dirt, rocks, concrete, glass, plastic, or wood
- 26. No Mercury Switches, Pumps, Gauges, or Mercury Containing Sources

Acceptance of your materials is strictly the determination of the Yard Inspection Personnel. Items containing any of the above will subject your load to rejection.
